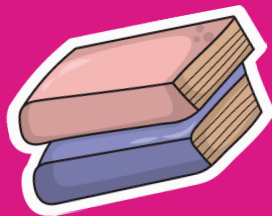

Libraries are a gift to the community. They give people the opportunity to improve themselves, to be better. Better informed. Better entertained. Better educated.

Grand Forks Public_ is more than just a library. Movies, video games, audiobooks, board games, technology, park passes—our list of offerings continually grows. Innovative programming brings the community together for laughter, learning, and connection.

In 2022, we created a multigenerational Musical Playground, expanded our social work intern program, hosted a fabulous Music and Mocktails event (thanks to our Friends!), and inspired young minds through LEGO and robotics programming. We digitized historic documents, delivered fun services to local assisted living facilities, and hosted yet another successful Haunted Stacks party. Our Summer Reading Program alone featured nearly 200 programs in June and July for kids, teens, and adults.

To top it all off, we received the 2022 North Dakota Star Library Award for exemplary service to the community! The award is based on per-capita circulation, service hours, program attendance, computer and Wi-Fi usage, and more. In 2022, we had 139,347 visitors with a service population of 72,705. This means there were 1.91 visits to GFP_ for every man, woman, and child in Grand Forks County.

We also surveyed our staff, which revealed 90% of our team finds their work meaningful, 93% are generally happy at work, and 100% agree that the library's work positively impacts people's lives. We truly believe in our mission.

We continue to boldly reimagine how we can best serve our patrons. We're committed to inspiring creativity and curiosity throughout our community. What are we capable of? And, what are you capable of?

The Friends Focus of “Retuning You in 2022” was one of our most all-encompassing and successful engagement campaigns to date. Throughout the year, the Friends hosted eight events ranging from the sublime (yoga) to the ridiculous (Zombie Barbie Makeovers). One of our most popular new events was our Mini Art Show, for which the Friends prepared and distributed 200 canvas kits allowing library patrons to become artists in a mini art show in the library’s Mezzanine Art Gallery. Eight local restaurants and service groups created signature non-alcoholic beverages with attendees voting to crown the Master of the Mocktail!

Love the library staff. They kindly answer all my questions—yes, even the silly ones.

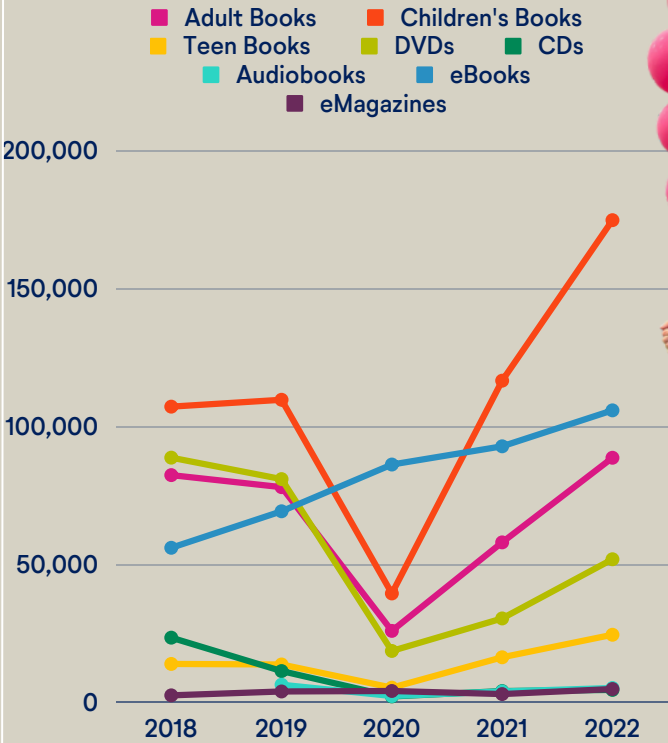

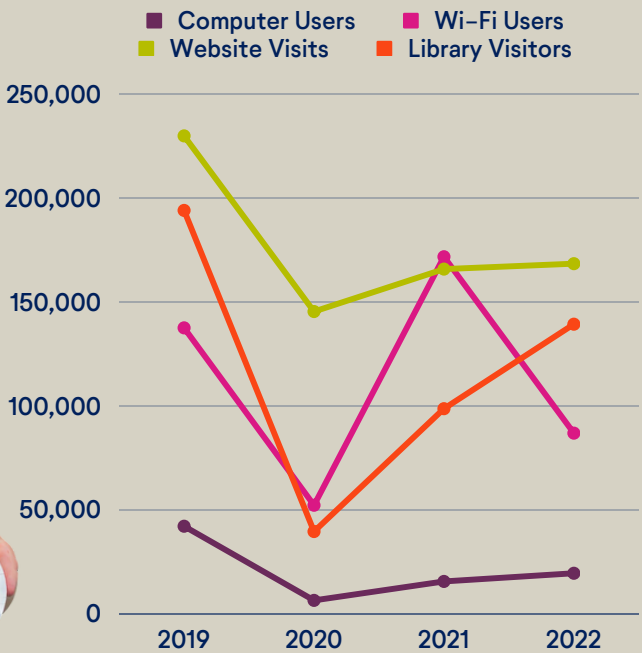
Program Attendance
